

# TERMS.

In placing before you this New Catalogue we must ask you to kindly take note of the following:

Accounts opened only if satisfactory references are received.

Terms: 21/20/0 discount allowed if payments are made within 30 days from date of invoice, otherwise, accounts are drawn for net at three months from date of Invoice.

**Prices:** Prices are quoted for quantities only, but for convenience sake we have priced most of the articles per piece.

Claims for damages or errors in delivery should be made on the carriers, as all goods leave our factory carefully packed and signed for as in good condition. Any inaccuracy should be notified to us within seven days after arrival of goods, as claims afterwards cannot be recognized.

Returns: All goods are checked prior to being packed, we therefore cannot accept Returns under ordinary circumstances; if however, the receiver believes that a mistake has been made on our side, or if there is any other reason for returning goods, it is necessary under all circumstances to correspond about this and come to an arrangement with us before returning such goods.

Orders: It is necessary with every order to quote the number and bye numbers, and in order to prevent errors the name of all required articles should be exactly stated.

Delivery: We keep a large stock of all lines so as to send goods off at once in most cases, but it is very advisable to place Season Orders as early as ever possible as we have to execute all orders in rotation.

Electros: Electros can be supplied for every line; these will be charged for at cost, and the full value will be refunded as soon as we receive the Electros back.

Goods: Goods supplied to the Trade only, no Catalogues are sent to private persons.










Shape of Lanterns 950, 1000, 1100
